# Wh...

Question Word	Asking About...	Example
What	A thing, an animal, specific information.	<b>What</b> is your name?
Who	A person.	<b>Who</b> is your teacher?
Where	A place.	<b>Where</b> is my cat?
When	Time.	<b>When</b> is your birthday?
Whose	Possession.	<b>Whose</b> bike is it?
Which	A choice.	<b>Which</b> pencil do you want?
Why	A reason.	<b>Why</b> do you say that?

# How ...

Question Word	Asking About...	Example
How	A manner, a condition or a quality.	<b>How</b> are you?
How far	A distance.	<b>How far</b> is Quebec from Montreal?
How long	A length (time or space).	<b>How long</b> is this movie?
How many	A quantity (countable).	<b>How many</b> cars do you have?
How much	A quantity (uncountable).	<b>How much</b> money do you have?
How old	Age.	<b>How old</b> are you?
